Provisional Air Quality Policy for Local League Play Only Adopted August 9, 2024 Outdoor Matches Only

Website that must be used: airnow.gov

Captains or individual players may request a reschedule due to poor air quality if the AQI is unhealthy, which is 151 and higher at match time. All players must use the Website airnow.gov to monitor the air quality and may not utilize this policy for decision making on matches more than 1 hour prior to the scheduled match time.

Even if both captains and/or all players do not agree, there will be no default for a line or a team match that is rescheduled under this policy. If indoor courts are available and accessible, and if both captains agree, they can play on indoor courts at the players' own expense.

The League Coordinator must be contacted for all rescheduled matches and those rescheduled matches or lines must be completed within 10 days of the originally scheduled match, or, if 10 days are not left, matches must be completed by the league end date. Once a reschedule date has been set and the respective league coordinator has been notified, that becomes the match date and cannot be changed unless conditions do not permit play. (See section A.4a-c)

All matches not completed by the end of league date or extended deadline will result in a double default. It is required that matches play a minimum number of lines. (See section A.2a-c).
