Position Title: **Community Tennis Instructor and/or tournament assistant**

USTA Intermountain/Idaho – Idaho Tennis Association

Reports to: Idaho Tennis Association (IdTA) Junior Program Coordinator and/or the Social Programs Coordinator depending on the program type.

Status: Part-Time, Seasonal depending on the duties, Non-exempt position

Year: 2026

Purpose of Position:

To provide tennis instruction for Tennis is Elementary, Play Days, or Social Tennis for adults 18 and older. Additionally, an opportunity to work a tournament desk for either junior tournaments and/or adult league district events as needed

Position Duties:

- TIE/Play Days – Set up and tear down of equipment along with tennis instruction to participants, follow school/facility protocol for safety of the participants in the class or play day
- Social Tennis – Instruction and/or coordination of play for the 1.5 hours per class
- Tournament Desk – Assist or run a site for junior events or adult league district events - put players on the court, record and report scores
- Other duties as assigned

Measurements:

- Parent/player feedback
- Being on time for set up and teaching

Internal Relationships:

- For all junior programs and tournaments, this position reports to the Junior Program Coordinator

- For all adult programs, this position reports to the Social Programs Coordinator

Ideal Qualifications:

- Knowledge or experience teaching tennis to adults and/or juniors
- Safe Sport Approved – **this is required** prior to working at any site which includes passing a background check
- Ability to work well with others
 - Large group management skills
- Tennis background

Compensation:

- Tennis Is Elementary Instructor - \$40.00/hour
- Social Tennis Instructor/site coordinator - \$40.00/hour
- Assisting with Play Days - \$40.00/hour
- Tournament Desk junior event or Adult League District event - \$23.00/hour
- Trainings - \$20.00/hour
